### A few reminders (please review)

The Lamar Orchestra Department is adopting the following terms for this trip.

- Students attending must be passing all classes
- Students attending MUST maintain a 90% attendance rate
- Students attending MUST and should be an outstanding ambassador of the Lamar Orchestra Program during the 2024-2025 school year. This includes but is not limited to having no serious discipline infractions such as, physical and verbal aggression, bullying of any type, and possession of prohibited items/substances. Please see the Lamar Student Handbook for a full list of details. Please let me know if you have any questions.
- If the student fails to perform at the highest level they can in their musical performances, this could result in them not performing at Disney (if student is in Symphony or selected to perform through audition).

### Chaperone Needs:

**If you are a parent/caregiver who wishes to chaperone for the trip you will need to do the following in addition to your individual payment.**

Please review the following details before you confirm with Lamar Orchestra and before you register with Perform America as a chaperone. Please respond to this email to agree with the responsibilities below and to confirm you will be a Lamar chaperone.

As a Lamar Chaperone, who will be directly responsible for AISD students, you must complete/agree to the following items:

- AISD requires all volunteers who will be alone with students to complete the background check by clicking the link below. Please complete the preliminary background check before 4/9. If you have already completed this for another volunteer role at Lamar during the 2023-2024 school year, you do not need to complete it again. - Failure to pass the background check will result in ineligibility for this trip and refunds will not be issued.
- Chaperones will be responsible for holding/administering medications for students in their assigned group. Additional training may be required prior to the trip.
- Chaperones must coordinate with directors, travel agents, and students to follow all trip schedules and events. Chaperones must also refer to the directors with any discipline issues, scheduling changes/issues, emergency situations, and student guardian communication. All communications with students, guardians, and staff are confidential.
- Chaperones assigned to 6th and 7th grade students must stay with students at the parks at all times. Chaperones assigned to 8th grade students will not need to stay with students at the park but must stay in communication with their assigned students. (requires student/guardian consent)
- The Chaperone double occupancy room rate is \$2,105. When registering with perform America you will reserve the chaperon double room rate.
